Call for applications for visual artists (Villa Waldberta, 1 position)

Residency period: 09 January to 27 March 2025

Application period: 01 June to 15 July 2024, 23:59 pm (CET)

ARTIST IN RESIDENCE MUNICH / Villa Waldberta - the residency programme of the City of Munich - and the non-profit art association Rosa Stern Space offer a working residency for a professional visual artist. The artist lives in the Villa Waldberta in Feldafing on Lake Starnberg and works on a project of his/her choice with the support of the Villa Waldberta and Rosa Stern Space team. Participation in at least one public event in the Villa Waldberta and a presentation at NEBYULA (art space run by Rosa Stern Space) is expected.

Villa Waldberta

The Villa Waldberta in Feldafing on Lake Starnberg has five flats. The salons on the ground floor are suitable for communal activities with the other guest artists and are regularly used for events. The Villa Waldberta includes a large park, the so-called Chauffeurshäusl with another flat, and the Palmenhaus, a 70 m² studio that can be used year-round as a (shared) workspace and for exhibitions, but also for other event formats.

Rosa Stern Space

Rosa Stern Space e.V. is a non-profit association and independent artistic production and presentation venue. Since 2024, the association has operated the new exhibition space NEBYULA in Munich's Maxvorstadt. The focus is on a collaborative and networking approach with (inter-)national art and cultural actors. The programming is based on the principle of sustainable dialogues and growing communities to create places of collective empowerment and inclusive structures, shaped by future-oriented issues and newly emerging interspaces. The goal is to promote visual arts and their intersections with all other forms of artistic expression.

Remuneration

Within the framework of the residency programme, the guest artist receives a stipend of 1200€ per month from the City of Munich. The accommodation with own kitchen and bathroom is rent-free, the costs for travel expenses (economy class) up to an amount of 350€ within Europe and up to 800€ if travelling from outside Europe will be reimbursed, as well as the monthly tickets for the public transport in Munich.

Application

We kindly ask you to send your application documents (in English or German) compiled into a single PDF file (max. 10 MB) to [opencall\[at\]rosastern.space](mailto:opencall[at]rosastern.space) by **July 15, 2024**. The documents should include:

- A statement of interest in the residency and ideas for a work project (max. 2 pages text + max. 4 pages visualization)
- CV (max. 2 pages)
- Artistic portfolio (max. 20 pages)

Applications that do not meet these criteria will not be considered.

The period of the work stay cannot be postponed, significantly shortened or split. Applications in pairs or teams are not possible. We welcome applications from people of all nationalities, religions, sexual identities, ages and social backgrounds. Villa Waldberta is not barrier-free.

Requirements

- Persons who have already stayed at Villa Waldberta or Ebenböckhaus are not admitted.
- The applicant's place of residence must be outside Bavaria.
- Applicants must practice their art professionally and full-time
- Applicants may work in any field of art, including painting, drawing, sculpture, photography, film, video, digital art and performance or a combination of media.
- Good command of English
- Personal application (no application through a third party)
- The applicant must fulfil all contractual requirements of the City of Munich as operator of Villa Waldberta. The selected candidate will receive a separate contract.

Jury and selection

The selection will be made by a panel consisting of representatives from NEBYULA / Rosa Stern Space e.V., ARTIST IN RESIDENCE MUNICH, and the Department of Arts and Culture of the City of Munich. By September 1st, five candidates will be chosen and invited to an online interview. The final decision will be made and communicated by September 15, 2024.
